




DRIVE CANADA TRACKER

Once you have your tracker log in (email address and the password I give you), you can enter it at gpslive.co.uk




This screen will allow to access to the tracker. Just click on the box (1) and then click the grey circle to give you my whereabouts (2).




You can choose a route history and you should also see my current position, as well as any stops I make.

The tracker is so accurate that if you zoom in, you'll see where I've stopped for petrol or lunch! The "P" parking signs on the route show anywhere I've stopped for more than a few minutes.



The red line on the image shows the history of my route. You can opt for the past 24 hours, or up to a week or more. In some areas, I may lose signal and this will be shown as a straight red line which clearly links to signal hits, rather than track along the road.

You can also find our my altitude and other data in this blue bar. Sadly, there is also an option to track my speed!



If you have a smartphone, you'll be diverted to a different layout, but the controls are the same. Just ensure you have selected "Graham" as the device and then look for the history of the route.

If you get stuck, use the **help file**. This has all the info you'll need to use the tracking software on a computer or a smartphone/tablet.
